The **Government of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines** has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the **OECS Regional Health Project**, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consultant will be expected to assist with the management and implementation of environmental safeguards functions in the Public Sector Investment Project Management Unit (PSIPMU). Duties will include:

1. Assisting the PSIPMU to apply the necessary measures to comply with the environmental commitments of the project as specified in relevant safeguards documents
2. Supporting the stakeholder engagement process, community outreach as well as implementation, monitoring and reporting of the Project level grievance redress mechanisms (GRM).
3. Identifying and managing environmental and social issues associated with project activities
4. Performing any other duties in line with the scope of the assignment leading to compliance with environmental safeguards and related instruments.
