2024 Project Highlights Summary

- Single Window for Land Property Transactions (SWLPTS) - While Aerial Imagery and Geodetic Survey procurements are in motion, handover and training on the use of the new cadastral survey equipment was completed.
- Customs Single Window for Trade Transactions - The Customs and Excise Department has begun preparations for Vincy Single Window for Trade Facilitation (VSWIFT) with United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD). The VSWIFT will provide greater efficiency through reliable digital services relevant to SVG imports and exports.
- **Procurements:** Other procurement progress include key digital infrastructure components, such as Data Centre IT hardware and technical evaluation of bids for the Tax Implementation Management System (TIMS). Upcoming Bids focus on the Citizen Portal and cybersecurity enhancements, with finalization and review processes underway.
