



## **Consultancy opportunity – Supervision of Ashton Lagoon coastal engineering project**

Sustainable Grenadines Inc. (SusGren) is a non-governmental organization (NGO) whose mandate is integrated sustainable development and biodiversity conservation in the Grenadine Islands. SusGren is executing a project to restore the ecosystems of Ashton Lagoon, Union Island, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines. The project involves engineering works to deconstruct an abandoned pier in Ashton Lagoon in order to restore water circulation to the area and improve habitat for marine life. Phase I of these works will be performed by a construction contractor experienced in coastal /marine works commencing September 2017.

SusGren now seeks a suitably qualified individual or firm to supervise the contractor's performance of Phase I of the Engineering Works to the Abandoned Pier in Ashton Lagoon.

This assignment includes, *inter alia*:

1. Approving the Contractor's proposed methods.
2. Inspecting the Works and overseeing compliance with the Construction Contract, Drawings, Technical Specifications and applicable legislation.
3. Issuing orders to the Contractor to make good any defective work, correct any faulty methodology and perform any additional tests as may be necessary.
4. Keeping records of inspections and preparing reports on the progress of construction.
5. Approving payments to the Contractor.
6. Assisting SusGren to resolve any disputes pertaining to the Construction Contract.
7. Inspecting the Works during the defects liability period, issuing orders to make good any defective work, issuing the Certificate of Completion and approving the as-built drawings.

SusGren invites interested individuals or firms experienced in supervising construction projects of a similar size (>100,000 USD) and nature (coastal engineering / earthworks) to submit proposals to perform the required services.
