A FLASH-FLOOD WATCH IS IN EFFECT FOR ST VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES UNTIL 12:00 NOON Thursday, 25th AUGUST 2022

Issued at 6:00pm, Wednesday 24th August, 2022

A tropical wave with a broad area of moisture trailing behind of it is forecast to produce roughly 50-60mm of rainfall across Saint Vincent and the Grenadines by Thursday afternoon according to model guidance.

Soils are already saturated from the previous rainfall events, therefore a Flash-Flood watch is in in effect until 12:00 noon, Thursday 25th August 2022. The flash-flood watch could either be extended or upgraded to a warning if conditions warrant.

Residents and motorists in areas prone to flooding and landslides or near rivers and streams should exercise caution.

A Flood-Watch is issued when conditions are favourable and there exists the possibility of flooding during the watch period

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
