Mr. Calder Benjamin Williams, Former Leader of the Opposition and former Member of Parliament, who passed away on Tuesday, March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022, will be accorded an Official Funeral on Friday, April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Official Viewing of the body will be held on Thursday, April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at the House of Assembly from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Officials and Dignitaries will be invited to the viewing from 10:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. Viewing for the general public will be from 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

The funeral service is scheduled to take place on Friday, April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at the New Testament Church of God, Chateaubelair, commencing at 12:00 p.m. This will be preceded by viewing and open tributes from 11:00 a.m. Interment will be at the Fitz Hughes Cemetery.

As a mark of respect, all flags throughout the State will be flown at half-mast on Friday, April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
