FOGGING SCHEDULE FOR 29TH MARCH – 1ST APRIL 2021

The Ministry of Health, Wellness and the Environment wishes to advise the general public that as part of the its mosquito control programme for the adult *Aedes aegypti* mosquito, the Insect Vector Control Unit will be conducting fogging operations at schools across St. Vincent and the island of Bequia commencing at **5:00 pm** daily.

In addition the following areas will be treated:

Wednesday, 31st March 2021 - Calder & Victoria Village

Thursday, 1st **April 2021** – Stubbs, Green Hill, Fountain, Cane Hall, Fairbane Pasture, Cedars, Keartons, Barrouallie, Three Rivers & South Rivers

Please take note of the following:

- Home and business owners in the named areas are reminded to keep their windows and doors open to allow the fog to eliminate the adult mosquitoes inside the home.
- Motorists are kindly asked to take caution.
- Persons who are suffering from any respiratory illnesses are kindly asked to take the necessary precautionary measures.
- Residents are also encouraged to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes in their yard and to protect themselves from mosquito bites during the day.
- Please note adverse weather conditions can affect fogging operations.
