Saint Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG) has received financing from the International Development Association (World Bank) towards the cost of the OECS Data for Decision Making Project (DDMP) (the Project). The Government of SVG (GoSVG) intends to hire a Procurement Officer to provide assistance to the Director of Economic Planning through his designate, the OECS DDMP Project Coordinator, in all contracts and procurement related matters, and provide contract management and contract execution supervision services for the various components of the Project.

The position of Procurement Officer is a contracted full-time staff position. Work will be performed at the office of the Project Implementation Unit (PIU), Ministry of Finance, Economic Planning and Information Technology located in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines.

The Officer will liaise closely with the relevant line ministries and departments within the GoSVG and with the World Bank’s project team. S/He will assist the Project Coordinator and shall be responsible for executing all procurement activities to be financed by the project, including bidding, selections and contract management and all other aspects of the OECS DDMP’s operations.

- Three (3) years’ experience in procurement and/or contract management of projects.
- Prior work in the public sector would be an asset.
