THE FLASH-FLOOD WATCH HAS BEEN EXTENDED UNTIL 6PM FRIDAY 30th

Issued at 6:00 am, Thursday 29th September, 2022

A predominantly southerly wind flow will bring equatorial moisture across Saint Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG) during the next couple of days. The southerly flow coupled with an upper level trough could result in a high chance of moderate to heavy showers and isolate thunderstorms. Model guidance is indicating 2 inches (~50mm) of rainfall across SVG by Thursday night with further accumulation on Friday.

Based on this prediction and due to the already saturated nature of the soil, the flash flood watch has been extended to 6pm Friday 30th, September 2022.

Residents and motorists in areas prone to flooding and landslides or near rivers and streams should exercise caution.

A Flood-Watch is issued when conditions are favourable and there exists the possibility of flooding during the watch period.

This flash-flood watch may be upgraded to a warning if conditions warrant.

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
