Government Enhancing Digital Transformation and Integrating Technology in the Classroom

Minister of Education, Vocational Training, Innovation, Digital Transformation and Information, Hon. Phillip Jackson has reaffirmed the Government's commitment to building a resilient, inclusive and modern nation, with education and digital transformation identified as central pillars of national development.
