### **Inland Revenue Department Reminds Taxpayers of March 31 Deadline**

The Inland Revenue Department (IRD) reminds taxpayers that several important tax obligations are due on **March 31**. Taxpayers are encouraged to ensure that all filings and payments are submitted on time to avoid penalties, interest, and unnecessary delays.

#### **1. Personal Income Tax Returns (Online Filing)**

- a. Employees** are required to file their **2025** Personal Income Tax Returns by **March 31**. The IRD advises that Personal Income Tax Returns must be filed online via the eTax portal at <https://etax.gov.vc>
- b. Sole Traders and Self-Employed Professionals** are required to:
  - Complete and submit their Income Tax Return via the manual form, and
  - Drop off the completed return, together with their Profit and Loss Statement and/or other supporting financial statements at the Customer Service Desk at the Inland Revenue Department's office in Kingstown.

#### **2. Corporate Income Tax Returns**

Businesses with a financial year ending **December 31** are reminded that their **Corporate Income Tax Returns** are due on **March 31**. Corporate Income Tax Returns are to be **dropped off at the Customer Service Desk** at the Inland Revenue Department's office in Kingstown.

#### **3. Estimated Tax – First Instalment**

All unincorporated businesses, self-employed professionals and companies with a **March, June, September and December** year end are reminded that the **instalment payment of Estimated Tax** is due on **March 31**.

#### **4. Economic Substance Returns**

All companies with a financial year ending **November 30** are reminded that their **Economic Substance Returns** must be submitted by **March 31**.

Economic Substance Returns may be submitted via email to [irdeconomicsubstance@gov.vc](mailto:irdeconomicsubstance@gov.vc).

## **5. Liquor Licences**

Businesses operating with **Liquor Licences** are reminded that renewals must be completed by **March 31** in order to remain compliant.

## **6. Motor Vehicle Licence (Registration Numbers Ending in 3 and Second Half Year ending in 9)**

Motorists with vehicle registration numbers ending in **3** and second half year with registration numbers ending in **9** are reminded that their Motor Vehicle Licence is due for renewal by **March 31**.

The Inland Revenue Department encourages taxpayers to submit their filings and payments early to avoid congestion and ensure timely processing. Persons requiring assistance are encouraged to contact the Department or visit our offices for guidance.

The IRD thanks taxpayers for their continued cooperation in meeting their tax obligations and contributing to national development.
