GOVERNMENT OF MEXICO DONATES ASTRAZENECA VACCINES TO THE PEOPLE OF ST. VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES

SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES, Friday, February 18, 2022 – Today, a Mexican aircraft landed at the Argyle International Airport carrying ten thousand (10,000) doses of the Aztrazeneca vaccine to donate to the Government and People of St. Vincent and the Grenadines from the Government of Mexico to help fight the COVID-19 pandemic. The Mexican delegation was headed by Dr. Laura Elena Carrillo Cubillas, Executive Director of the Mexican Agency of International Cooperation for Development (AMEXCID).

A short handing over ceremony of the items took take place at the Argyle International Airport. Senator The Honourable Keisal M. Peters, Minister of State with responsibility for Foreign Affairs and Foreign Trade, Mr. Joel Providence, Honorary Consul of Mexico, and Mr. Cuthbert Knights, Permanent Secretary within the Ministry of Health, Wellness and the Environment, were on hand to witness the handing over of the items.
