The Ministry of Transport, Works, Lands and Physical Planning in association with the Ministry of Tourism, Civil Aviation, Sustainable Development and Culture and the National Parks, Rivers and Beaches Authority would like to inform the general public that the Rehabilitation of Villa Boardwalk Project has commenced.

From Monday, October 11, 2021, the first section of boardwalk between Mariner's Inn and the Young Island Dock will not be accessible and pedestrians are asked to utilize the road entry to the Young Island Dock as the principal access.

Works to the second section of boardwalk, between the Aquatic Club Jetty and Paradise Beach Hotel will commence after the first section of the boardwalk has been rehabilitated. The project is expected to be completed in 5 months.

For your safety, please follow all signage and exercise extreme caution when using the boardwalk as some sections will be hoarded and have active construction.

As work progresses, we will continue to update you on any changes for boardwalk and beach access.

We thank you for your patience, diligence and cooperation.
