### **Reparations Advocacy To Continue**

Minister of Foreign Affairs Hon. Fitzgerald Bramble says the issue of reparatory justice also featured prominently at the recent Heads of Government meeting in St. Kitts and Nevis and will continue to be advanced at the upcoming Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting in Antigua and Barbuda.

Among proposals discussed at the recent Heads of Government meeting in St. Kitts and Nevis, was the concept of deeper regional cooperation in disaster management leveraging collective resources to respond more effectively to hurricanes and other climate-related shocks. “One disaster affecting one island ultimately impacts the region. We must strengthen our collective response mechanisms,” the Minister said.

Minister Bramble confirmed he will represent St. Vincent and the Grenadines at the Commonwealth Foreign Ministers Meeting in London next week, where the reparations agenda will be further discussed. “The legacy of colonialism continues to impact our development. Reparations remain an important element of our broader socioeconomic strategy,” he said.

He encouraged citizens to continue contributing to national development efforts. “Government will continue to work in your interest. Together, through unity and proactive engagement, we can build a stronger and more resilient St. Vincent and the Grenadines.”
