

COMMUNITY ARTISTIC PROJECT

"Tzompantli, Artistic Reflection 2021"

Objective

To execute the second edition of ***"Tzompantli, Artistic Reflection 2021"***.

Methodology

An open call will be launched through IME, inviting the **Mexican and Foreign** artistic community to create a painting (using any technique) with the central design being the skull of a Mexican *calavera*.

Each design must be photographed by the artist to be sent in .jpg format. All received images will be entered into the ***Tzompantli 2021*** database and the result based on the community's reflection on this year's experiences.

The exhibition of the artworks received will be done through an electronic magazine which will be transmitted to all Mexican Foreign Affairs officials via e-mail, as well as shared via social media networks.

Characteristics of the artwork:

- It must be created exclusively using the shape of a Mexican *calavera* skull.
- It can be created with any technique: drawing, intervened photography, watercolour, yarn, beads, etc.

Characteristics of the digital image:

- Once the piece is completed, the artist is required to take a photo of it, retouch and/or crop it.
- The size of the digital image should be at least 2000 pixels in jpg or pdf format.
- The artworks must be sent to the following e-mail addresses: lalvar@sre.gob.mx and dventura@sre.gob.mx.
- Each email must include:
 - Name of the artist,
 - Title of the piece,
 - Technique used,
 - City and country of residence,

- A sentence (in English and Spanish) describing **what 2021 has meant to the artist**.

NOTE: If artworks are not submitted with any of the above details, they will not be considered as part of the digital magazine.

KEY DATES:

- Wednesday 22nd September: Dissemination of call for entries.
- Monday 25th October: Deadline for reception of artworks (23:59 hrs Mexico time).
- Monday 1st November and throughout said month, the link for the electronic magazine will be circulated to all Mexican Foreign Affairs officials via e-mail, as well as published on social media.
