### **FOGGING SCHEDULE FOR 1<sup>ST</sup> – 4<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2021**

The Ministry of Health, Wellness and the Environment wishes to advise the general public that as part of its mosquito control programme for the adult *Aedes aegypti* mosquito, the Insect Vector Control Unit will be conducting fogging operations in the following areas commencing at **5:00 pm** daily.

**Monday, 1<sup>st</sup> February 2021** – Layout, Richmond, Stubbs, Lodge Village, Old Montrose, Hadley's Village, South Union & South Rivers

**Tuesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2021** – Layout, Chateaubelair, Carapan, Victoria Village, Old Montrose, Spring, South Union & South Rivers

**Wednesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2021** – Barrouallie, Chateaubelair, Calder, Calder Ridge, Kingstown Park, North Union & Park Hill

**Thursday, 4<sup>th</sup> February 2021** – Barrouallie, Fitz Hughes, Mount Pleasant, Paul Over, North Union, New Grounds & Park Hill

Please take note of the following:

- Home and business owners in the named areas are reminded to keep their windows and doors open to allow the fog to eliminate the adult mosquitoes inside the home.
- Motorists are kindly asked to take caution.
- Persons who are suffering from any respiratory illnesses are kindly asked to take the necessary precautionary measures.
- Residents are also encouraged to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes in their yard and to protect themselves from mosquito bites during the day.
- Please note adverse weather conditions can affect fogging operations.
